Know Your Rights on Pro

5 Key Messages

Green and Black Cross

1. No Comment

You don't have to talk to police on the streets, if there's a Stop and Search you are arrested. Best to stay silent or reply with 'no comment' in interview until you talk to a good lawyer.



2. No Personal Details

Officers may try to get personal details. You are not legally required to give them, even in a stop and search, unless a specific power is used or a warrant is issued.

3. Under What Power?

If police ask you to do something, ask them if you are legally obliged to do it. 'Under what power'? If you aren't obliged or don't answer, you can't be punished for it.









Know Your Rights on P 5 Key Messages









1. No Comment

You don't have to talk to police on the streets, if there's a Stop and Search or if you are arrested. Best to be silent or reply with 'no comment'. If you are arrested, say 'no comment'. Do not give an interview until you talk to a lawyer.









2. No Personal Details

Officers may try to get personal details. You are not legally required to provide personal details, even in a stop and search, unless a specific power is used. A Fixed Penalty Notice is issued.









3. Under What Power

If police ask you to do something, you can refuse to do it if you are not legally obliged to do so. You can ask them if you are legally obliged to do it, and if they say 'no', you can refuse to answer and 'under what power' they are stopping you. If you aren't obliged or they don't say you are, you aren't obliged to do anything. If you aren't obliged or they don't say you are, you don't have to do anything.









4. No Duty Solicitor

If arrested, do not use the solicitor on duty but get a lawyer experienced in criminal law – in London, use any of the following: Bindmans, ITN or Common Law. We also recommend that you inform GBC from the police station via your 'one call' – 07946 54









5. No Caution

Police often try to get people a **caution**, which goes on c records. We recommend not one unless a good lawyer rec it. If you're offered one, it's be police want you to take it– th doing you a favour.
