

Pause mode

From the start of May 2019, Green and Black Cross (GBC) is pausing all support activity for around 3 months. Our usual phone support line – 07946 541511 – will still be operational thanks to our friends at Activist Court Aid Brigade (ACAB) during this time, but it will not be available 24/7 and will focus on direct support to people planning to go on an action, to arrestees and defendants.

The phone will not be able to take requests for training, for LO support or for direct contact with GBC. If you have a training request and are happy to wait a couple of months, you can email <u>gbctrainings@protonmail.com</u> to lodge it and we'll get back to you as soon as we're arranging trainings again.

- Coordinating Legal Observer support
- Providing training
- Liaising with other organisations
- Responding to emails.
